One time grant of \$500 will be made to one student to defrav the cost of tuition, books, or room & board at an accredited institution of higher learning approved by the New York Rural Water Association. Disbursement of the money will be made upon presentation of winner's college invoice as proof of enrollment. Applicants must be a citizen or legal resident of the United States, a resident of the State of New York and reside on a water system that is a member of the NYRWA. In order to be eligible for a scholarship, applicants must complete the application form in its entirety and return it to the NYRWA by the entry postmark deadline, February 3, 2025. All applications will be first screened on the basis of leadership responsibilities in community activities, school activities and on grade point average. Scholarship recipients will be selected on the basis of the number, length of commitment, and quality of leadership responsibilities in community and school activities, awards, honors, academic record, career goals and financial need. Priority will be given but not necessarily limited to water-related studies. Recipients will be notified by mail and will be announced at the NYRWA Annual Conference. Acceptance of scholarship constitutes permission to use recipient's name and/or likeness for purposes of advertising. No transfer of scholarship is permitted. Applicants must plan to attend an accredited school in the Fall of 2025.
